Amended fund rules - Microcap Sverige, Microcap Norden and Nanocap Sverige

We will be changing the fund rules on 20 March 2024 for the mutual funds listed below. The changes do not impact the fund's investment focus or risk level and do not result in any additional costs to you as a unit holder. You do not need to take any action as a result of this information.

- Handelsbanken Microcap Sverige
- Handelsbanken Microcap Norden
- Handelsbanken Nanocap Sverige

Modified reference with regard to small caps

The section on investment focus within the fund rules states what is referred to as small caps. As a result of the changes, the definition of small caps will be consistent with the changes already implemented in our other small cap funds.

The reference in the current fund rules states that a company's market value at the time of the investment may not exceed 0.1 % (Microcap Sverige) and 0.05 % (Microcap Norden and Nanocap Sverige) of the total stock market value.¹ This is replaced with the reference that investments are permitted in companies whose market value at the time of the investment do not exceed the market value for the largest company in the benchmark index of each fund. In simplified terms, this means that the frame of reference for small caps is not related to the total stock market value but is instead linked to the benchmark index of each fund.

Editorial changes

We also updated the wording about sustainability and valuation to be consistent with several of our other funds for the purpose of enhancing the uniformity in our fund rules.

Amended fund rules

The changes have been approved by the Swedish Financial Supervisory Authority. The updated fund rules, fact sheet and prospectus will be available in the list of funds as of 20 March at <u>www.handelsbankenfonder.se</u>.
